

RULES FOR THE AWARD OF A CERTIFICATE OF COMMENDATION

1. Ladies' Sections may submit recommendations for the award of a Certificate of Commendation for any member who, in their opinion, has performed outstanding services and is deserving of recognition for her activities on behalf of the Section, the Branch and the Association as a whole. Length of membership and amount of money raised, whilst being major considerations for an award, will not in themselves justify the award of a Certificate.
2. Usually, not more than three Certificates of Commendation will be awarded in any one year.
3. Where a Branch does not have an official Ladies' Section, the Branch Committee may put forward the name of a Lady (provided that she is the wife or other relative of a full member of that Branch, or has herself served on attachment to a Gunner Unit), who in their opinion has given outstanding service to the Branch.
4. Recommendation forms are enclosed. The completed form must be signed by the Branch Chairman, District Representative, and Regional Representative and must be received at Artillery House NOT LATER THAN 15th January.
