

RULES FOR THE AWARD OF A CERTIFICATE OF MERIT

1. The object of the Certificate of Merit is to recognise outstanding services to the Royal Artillery Association by an annual or life member.
2. There is no restriction on the number of nominations that may be made each year, but:
 - a. Usually, not more than three or four certificates will be awarded in any one year.
 - b. Not more than one certificate will normally be awarded to any District in any one year.
 - c. Current members of the National Executive Committee are not eligible for nomination.
 - d. Length of membership, whilst being a major consideration, will not in itself justify the award of a Certificate of Merit.
3. Nomination forms are enclosed. The completed form must be signed by the Branch Chairman, District Representative and Regional Representative, and must be received at Artillery House NOT LATER THAN 15th January.
4. Selections for Certificates of Merit will be made by the National Executive Committee at its Spring Meeting.
